**Application Process:**

1. All application forms and letters of reference shall be received by April 15, 2010. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
2. All applications will be reviewed by May 15, 2010, after which the most qualified applicants will be interviewed at the church by the scholarship committee members.
3. Scholarship(s) will be awarded in June of 2010.
