WHAT	A Lehigh Presbytery Helping Hands work trip to assist people in Oakville, Iowa who were affected by flooding in June 2008.
WHEN	April 18 – April 26, 2009
WHERE	Oakville, Iowa (housing in Mediapolis, Iowa)
WHO	Adults – 18 and older (construction experience recommended) ready to help and provide hope to others.
WORK	Reconstruction projects on damaged homes. Skills such as plumbing, electric, drywall, millwork and painting are needed. Be prepared to BE FLEXIBLE and provide whatever help is needed.
LODGING	We will be staying with families of the First United Presbyterian Church in Mediapolis, Iowa. The hospitality and Christian fellowship is second to none!
FOOD AND WATER	Meals will be provided by several churches of Mediapolis including the host site of First United Presbyterian. Breakfast will be with host families and bag lunches are provided for workdays. Evening meals are served at First United. A couple of meals may be purchased at restaurants while traveling to/from Iowa.
TRAVEL	We will drive in church and/or rented vans to Mediapolis. A 2 day trip is planned with an overnight spent with members of a host church or motel room. (This is still being investigated.)
COST TO PARTICIPANTS	\$160.00 Registration fee plus the cost of meals while traveling and incidental expenses for personal items.
