## SCIENTISTS IN CONGREGATIONS

We are very thankful for all of those who participated in the conversation about a potential grant proposal with the John Templeton Foundation to facilitate a deeper understanding and dialogue between the disciplines of Science and Theology within our community. Here is what we are able to report at this time: The Da Vinci Science Center has agreed to partner with us on this project by hosting four symposiums at the center in September, October, November, and December 2012. These gatherings will bring together scientists and theologians from the Lehigh Valley to participate in an open dialogue around the given topic. Prior to those gatherings, the proposal suggests that some of the money be used to hire a video production company to collect interviews around these topics (videos will be shot from January-March 2012) with experts in the field of the particular topics of choice. While that is happening, an Editorial Advisory Committee will be formed from within our congregation who will write a curriculum for small group usage within FPCA. These small groups, similar to the ones we just experienced during Lent, will take place in the Fall of 2012. 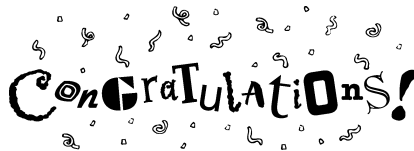
## SUMMER CAMP AT BRAINERD

## YOUR STEPHEN MINISTRY: CONFIDENTIAL ONE-TO-ONE CHRISTIAN CARING



May 8<sup>th</sup> was a special day in the life of First Presbyterian Church of Allentown when fifteen members were commissioned as Stephen Ministers during worship services. Prior to being anointed by our Pastors, each one heard that he/she has been called and gifted by God to carry out the ministry of one on one Christian care giving in our congregation *and* the larger community. They each vowed that he/she was prepared to nurture the skills each learned in over 50 hours of classroom instruction in providing service to others- to support, encourage, build up, and comfort people in all their needs.

The commissioning service marked the “end of the beginning” for Stephen Ministry here at our church. Kathy Mammele, Stephen Leader Referrals Coordinator, has been busy lately as she has begun the task of matching a Stephen Minister with a *care receiver*, a person in our congregation or the broader Lehigh Valley community who is experiencing a crisis or other stress in his/her life and is in need of help and support.

With over 10,000 churches and organizations in the world participating in Stephen Ministry, there is no lack of testimonials from former and current care receivers:

- “I thank God every day for my Stephen Minister. I don’t know how I could have made it through the past year without her.”
- “Before I had a Stephen Minister, I struggled with whether I even believed in God anymore. Now I have seen God’s love face to face through my Stephen Minister.”
- “I was hurting so much I couldn’t see straight. But I discovered the healing love of Jesus through my Stephen Minister. I can’t say enough about Stephen Ministry.”
- “As a man, I found it difficult and awkward to reach out for help. But I am glad I did. I probably could have made it alone, but it sure was a lot easier having a Stephen Minister, another man to talk to.”

The second phase of Stephen Ministry has begun with bi-weekly peer supervision group sessions and continuing education meetings already in progress for our Stephen Ministers. The Pastors and Stephen Leaders of FPCA are very proud of the commitment each of these gifted men and women have made.

Stephen Ministry is **YOUR** ministry. It is an important way we at FPCA care for one another. If you are going through a difficult time, consider having a Stephen Minister. If you know of someone else who is facing difficulties, suggest that he/she request Stephen Ministry. 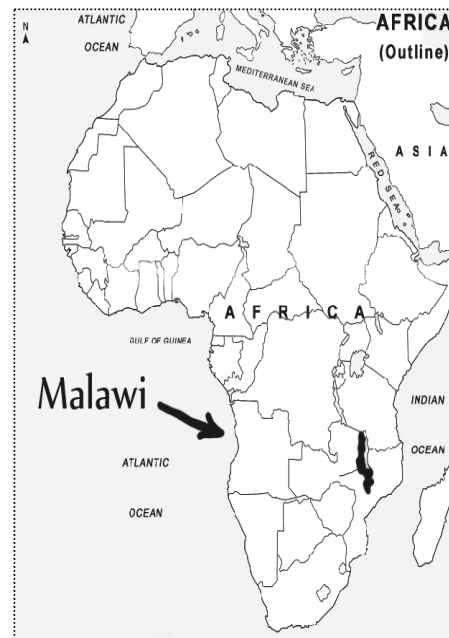

## EXPLORING MALAWI

*As an exploratory team prepares to leave FPC for Malawi to discern the Holy Spirit’s calling, we seek to learn more about the country and our brothers and sisters who live there.*

**Can you imagine living in a country where the life expectancy at birth is only 51.7 years? How would that change your family?** Consider how many of your loved ones would be living? Fortunately for us, we are blessed to live in the United States where the life expectancy is far greater; but what about the people of Malawi, where **a long life is 51.7 years?** According to the U.S. Central Intelligence Agency’s World Factbook, Malawi’s 15,879,252 population estimate takes “into account the effects of **excess mortality** due to AIDS; this can result in lower life expectancy, higher infant mortality, higher death rates...” In addition, the agency states there is a “**very high**” degree of risk of infectious diseases, including hepatitis A, typhoid fever, malaria and plague.

*Jesus commanded us to love our neighbors... including those neighbors who live in a country in Africa named, Malawi. Please support the exploratory team with your prayers.
