1. All application forms and letters of reference shall be received by April 15.



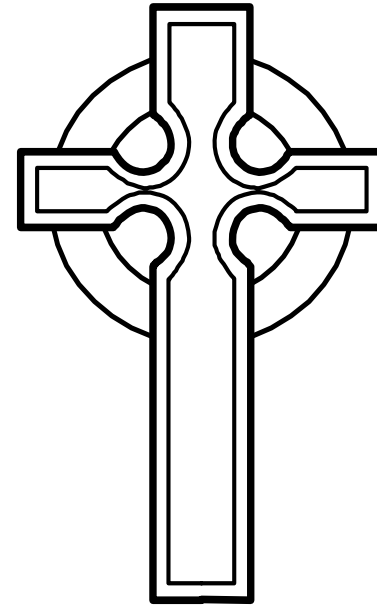
2. All applications will be reviewed by May 15.

THE MOTIVATION AND PURPOSE OF THIS SCHOLARSHIP

Upon the death of her infant daughter, Natalie Theresa in 1996, her mother, Amy, desired to establish a scholarship fund in Natalie's memory through First Presbyterian Church of Allentown.

The intended purpose of the scholarship is to assist those who desire to pursue or enhance a career which focuses on the nurturing of children. This could include, but is not necessarily limited to: day care...early childhood education...public school teaching...healthcare...social work or ministry.

The concept of this scholarship fund was approved by the Session of First Presbyterian Church of Allentown in 2004. It is awarded annually to qualified applicants who are in need of financial assistance, and is to be held in perpetuity.
